RE: COVID-19 CASES INVOLVING FOREIGN WORKERS EMPLOYED BY PORT SERVICE CONTRACTORS IN PORT KLANG

The Management of Northport has been informed of an outbreak of COVID-19 cases among foreign workers employed by port service contractor companies in Port Klang. The spread is reported to have occurred at the foreign workers' living quarters in Pulau Indah.

As the safety and health of our stakeholders is of paramount importance, Northport has taken immediate and proactive actions by temporarily suspending the operation of the affected port service contractors and prohibiting the entry of employees of these contractors into Northport premises to avoid the risk of contagion, pending the results of the COVID-19 screening tests conducted on all employees of the companies involved.

As a precautionary measure, the Management of Northport has also carried out thorough disinfection of all areas exposed to the risk of transmission, in accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Health Malaysia.

As our business operations is running as usual, we advise all our valued customers and stakeholders to remain calm. Please refrain from spreading irresponsible fake news that could cause unnecessary panic.

Northport will continue to work closely with the Ministry of Health Malaysia, Port Klang Authority as well as other relevant government departments and agencies to ensure the well-being and safety of all our customers and stakeholders are protected.
